SPECIFIC ADDITIONAL PROTOCOL

BETWEEN

THE UNIVERSITY OF TURIN (ITALY) - FACULTY OF SCIENCES

AND THE

EWHA WOMANS UNIVERSITY (REPUBLIC OF KOREA) - COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING,

REGARDING STUDENTS EXCHANGE

Whereas the general cooperation agreement signed contemporary to this specific protocol between the University of Turin Faculty of Sciences, Italy, and the Ewha Womans University, College of Engineering, Republic of Korea

In order to give the opportunity to their students to broaden the scope of their academic curriculum through a unique learning experience abroad

The parties agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS:

Unless stated:

HOME INSTITUTION refers to the university from which the degree will be awarded.

HOST INSTITUTION means the university which has agreed to admit the student for a study abroad component receiving full accreditation for courses studied.

GENERAL PRINCIPLES:

The student exchange is founded on a reciprocal basis with the intention of achieving an equal number of units of exchange each way over a mutually agreed period of time.

There is no obligation on either institution to nominate students for the programme or to accept students.

IMPLEMENTATION MODALITIES:

The parties agree to exchange a maximum number of 10 students per party per academic year. The duration of the exchange will be agreed case by case according to common needs.

The Home institution will be responsible for screening and selecting students.

Students must be proficient in the language of instruction at the Host institution to qualify for nomination.

Exchange students will be subject to the academic rules and discipline of the Host institution.

The Host institution will assist wherever possible but is not obliged to provide housing or financial assistance.

Exchange students shall be responsible for obtaining their own visas and completing the required immigration formalities.

The persons in charge of the programme will be:

Prof. Claudio Cassardo, Faculty of Sciences of the University of Turin - Responsible of the Italian side

Prof. Seon Ki Park, Division of Environmental Science and Engineering of the Ewha Womans University, Responsible of the Korean side

STUDENT ENROLMENT, ATTENDANCE AND ASSESSMENT:

Exchange students will be permitted to enrol at the Host institution in any course of the Faculty of Sciences and of the College of Engineering for which they are qualified, subject to admission requirements, timetables and capacity constraints of the Host institution.

Students will obtain credits for courses in accordance with the regulations of the home institution. The Host institution will issue official transcripts of the credits obtained.

FEES AND SUBSIDIARY EXPENSES:

Exchange students will be enrolled in both institutions, but they will pay tuition and other fees only at their Home institution. Unless otherwise agreed, they will pay other personal expenses incurred at the Host institution, including visas, travel, accommodation and meals.

HEALTH INSURANCE:

All exchange students will be required to arrange adequate health insurance for the duration of the exchange.

MODIFICATION AND DURATION

This additional protocol may be modified by mutual agreement, in writing, and signed by the two parties. It has the same duration as the above mentioned agreement.
